

What is the

Regenerative Surf Congress?

The Third Regenerative Surf Congress will take place in Lobitos, Peru from October 30th until November 2nd, 2024. This concept has grown from exploring and sharing experiences of surf/skate-related organizations, researchers, companies and people to diving into all things regenerative and the variety of interventions that improve the quality of life in communities and enhance personal wellness.

The concept of Regenerative Surf is relatively new and encapsulates some of the language used in regenerative agriculture, regenerative travel, and/or surf conservation within the conceptual frameworks of circular and blue economies. The intention is to go beyond the vision of sustainability that simply aims to maintain resources for future generations. We're reframing reducing negative impacts to improving and making things better. The Congress takes a proactive approach in exploring ways in which surfing can restore and regenerate the nature environment, build resilient communities and contribute to social justice. During these three days different approaches are used to present diverse points of view, facilitate dialogue and cover a wide range of experiences from varied social and environmental contexts.

At the Inaugural Congress, we co-designed the concept of Regenerative Surf. In 2023, turned our collective attention to evaluating the impact members of the community are having where they live. We've created a narrative of surfing where various regenerative approaches to the surfing ecosystem not only influence the quality of life, but also strive for improvements to it including the local environments.

In a global situation where climate change, mental health and dependence on social media are alarming, it's even more important to foster connections to nature and common humanity. This green prescription, coupled with Intercultural exchange and social relationships, enhanced with time in the natural environment and knowledge exchange, we've created a powerful combination.


- 1. Connect networks and strengthen relationships between different organizations and people linked to the Regenerative Surf ideals within Peru and beyond.

The Lobitos Community



Lobitos is a fishing community in the north of Peru, a half hour via dirt road from the oil refining city of Talara. The Lobitos community is made up of approximately 1500 habitants between a military base, active oil extraction installations, and the vestiges of early English oil settlements and surfers. It is an undeniably special place. Dozens of buildings are abandoned and are evidence of the different occupations that the town has experienced throughout its history. Today, artisanal fishing continues to be the greatest resource for many families and the area is renowned for surfing, with more than 7 of its world-class waves.

Results from first two Regenerative Surf Congresses
